Hospital Employed Staff

All employed staff have relevant qualifications and experience appropriate to their profession and job function. The hospital personnel data base holds information on the number of staff employed and their personal details.

Clinical qualifications are checked with the appropriate professional register prior to an employment contract being issued. Staff are fully screened prior to commencement of employment, including Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) checks.

All staff working here are committed to meeting the patients' needs and expectations, and patients are encouraged to ask any member of staff for assistance at any time prior to, during your visit or afterwards.

Staff receive regular and appropriate clinical and customer services training and healthcare professionals are bound by their specific Code of Conduct relating to their profession.

The number of staff on duty at any one time is calculated according to the service being provided and the registered manager is responsible for ensuring adequate staffing levels to support skilled safe care. .
